- You can also call Karla at (614) 580-7267 or email her at zadnik.4@osu.edu before these dates to make other arrangements. She works at Ohio State in the College of Optometry (338 West Tenth Avenue, A400 Starling-Loving Hall), so you could make arrangements to drop your item off there or at her house on a different date, anytime before September 11.

No quilts will be accepted after 11pm on Tuesday, September 11.

All quilts must be picked up immediately after the show Tuesday night, or make other arrangements with Karla when you drop them off. I cannot receive quilts at the fall retreat, at the dates are too close to the show.
